What Happens Now?

St Anne's Nursery Pupils

If your child is currently at St Anne's Nursery, they will complete transition within school. Their Summer Books will be sent home shortly.

Home Visits for new pupils & parents

Monday 6th July 2026

Induction 'Stay & Play' Visit

Thursday 9th July 2026

All children are invited to come to St Anne's and play in Reception on **Thursday 9th July 2026** from **9.15am – 11.15am**.

Please come to the main entrance where I will meet the children and take them through to Reception class to play with their friends. Our current Nursery also join us.

Starting School in September

Thursday 3rd September 2026

All children will start St Anne's on **Thursday 3rd September 2026**

Children can arrive at any point from **8.30am – 8.45am**

Please bring your child to the front of the school and straight to the infant playground on their first day. From day 2 the normal morning procedure will take place.



Morning Procedure

From **Friday 4th September 2026**, children will join the KS1 on the staggered rolling entry at the front of the school via Blackwood Road. Children can arrive between **8.30am – 8.45am**.

Afternoon Procedure

Reception finish school at **3.15pm**. Please collect your child from the playground.



Some things Parents say about starting school:

- “Be Prepared”
- "Name everything"
- "Ensure they are able to do the simple essential life skills like use a knife and fork, take self to toilet, dress themselves etc."
- "If nothing else, make sure they can at least get themselves dressed."
- "Don't be surprised if your child is extremely tired after school for the whole first term."
- "Get organised, have a calendar with important dates and make extra time for tired children."
